



What is Impact 100 Seattle?

Impact 100 Seattle harnesses the collective power of diverse women to support and amplify the work of local community-based organizations, through high impact grantmaking and relationship building.

Together, we cultivate relationships and distribute unrestricted grants to small community based nonprofits in the Puget Sound area, guided by the principals of Trust-Based Philanthropy.

How Does it Work?

Each member contributes \$1000 to our grant pool, and every year, we aim to award at least one \$100,000 grant to small, local, community-based organizations. In addition to providing funding, we aim to support our partners beyond the check by employing the skills, connections, and resources of our diverse membership.

Why Does it Matter?

Collective giving amplifies individual giving and enables those who do not have access to billions of dollars to make a significant contribution to our community. It also democratizes giving by inviting women from diverse backgrounds, of different ages and socio-economic groups to join in the collective, connect with each other and learn together to better understand the issues of our community and ways that we can provide support.

What is an Impactship?

An Impactship is a no-strings/no financial commitment Impact 100 Seattle membership. Impactship members enjoy full membership benefits and participate in as much or as little of our programming as they would like. They are invited to join committees, serve on the Grant Review Team, or get involved in the Leadership Team and, of course, they have a vote in our final grant allocation.

What is the goal of an Impactship?

The goal of our Member Impactships is to strengthen our membership by broadening both our perspective and our reach to a diverse group of women in our community.

Who can receive an Impactship?

Women who are interested in becoming a member, but are not able to donate the full \$1000, are eligible to apply for an Impactship
