#### Benefits of Participating in KCEGP

- **Unrestricted Dollars** – use where needed most.
- **Unique Revenue Source** – Time Donation
- **Donor – Centric One Stop Shop**— all employees have one centralized place to give, can remain anonymous, and easily access everything needed for their taxes. Eligible employees can use up to three instances of volunteer time off a year for nonprofits in the program.
- **Efficient** – one report and one check/deposit for you saving you staff time and energy.
- **Low Risk & Low Cost** – no upfront cost. 10% of distributions. This helps cover a portion of program costs.
- **Higher Retention** – 74% higher retention rates YOY that average nonprofit donor retention (as compared to rates reported by AFP.)
