Thank you for your interest in the Kawabe Memorial Fund.

The Kawabe Memorial Fund supports general operations and programs of nonprofit agencies devoted to the care of low-income children, families and seniors. The Fund also provides a few capital grants to churches as well as scholarships to support teachers and the clergy. With the exception of the Seward scholarships, most grants are awarded to agencies and churches in the Seattle/King County Area.

Things to note:

- Proposals must be received by the due dates noted. Applications to the Kawabe Memorial Fund are due the second Friday in March, June or September.
- Prior to committee consideration of proposals, applicants may be asked to provide additional information by phone.
- The Kawabe Memorial Fund typically supports community-based organizations in the greater Seattle area with budgets of \$5 million or less.
- Grant requests for specific programs are encouraged but requests for general operating support will be considered. Grants from the Kawabe Memorial Fund are 1 year in duration.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of the Committee's funding decisions.
